Did You Know?

- Most every car manufactured after Sept 1st 2006 has a Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) In accordance to the US Federal Mandate known as the TREAD ACT.
- All direct TPMS sensors contain a sealed battery which cannot be replaced. Battery life is 5 years or 75,000 miles.

WHAT IS THE CONDITION OF YOUR SENSORS?

How They Work...

If your tire's air pressure is plus/minus 25% of the recommended pressure level for safe vehicle operation, the TPMS sensor sends a signal to your automobile's computer and the TPMS warning light illuminates. 

TPMS Saves Lives...

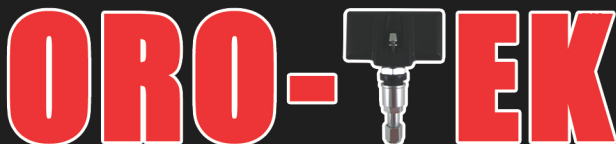
TPMS sensors help prevent dangerous blowouts by notifying you immediately when your tire's air pressure is below or above recommend levels.
