

HITCH BASKET BAG - SR8120

WARNINGS / LIMITATIONS

- · Mount Organizer to hitch rack before loading cargo.
- Do not use if your vehicle's exhaust pipe exits close to your hitch basket. The exhaust heat may damage your Hitch Bag Cargo Carrier and/or its contents.
- Do not exceed the manufacturer's hitch basket weight limit.

INSTALLATION

- · Place your bag on your hitch carrier platform with the zippered openings at the top, and the side with the buckles facing out (as shown in the photo).
- Unclip the two webbing straps.
- · Wrap each strap around both your Organizer and the hitch rack platform, then clip the two strap ends together.
- . After loading cargo, tighten the two straps to compress your bag down tightly on to your hitch carrier rack. To release a buckle just press in the sides.

LOADING AND UNLOADING

• W	hen loading distribute the weight evenly and put heavier items on the bottom.
• F	or security use a small padlock on the zipper.
	DRIVING
• P	ack items that can be damaged by water in plastic bags.
• D	o NOT exceed vehicle manufacturer's hitch rating.
• D	o NOT exceed speed limit. If you hear a flapping noise when driving, immediately pull over and check to make sure all straps are secure and tight.
	CARE
• T	o avoid mildew store your Hitch Bag Cargo Carrier only when completely dry.
• S	tore out of the sun in a cool, dry place.
• P	olyester fabric is intended for outdoor use, but is subject to color fading. Do not store in direct sunlight for long periods.
	CLEANING
• Yo	our Roof Bag Cargo Carrier may be cleaned with a soft brush and some lukewarm water. DO NOT USE SOAP as it may remove the protective coatings added by the fac- bry. Line dry.
