APPLICATION: 2007-2013 FORD EDGE & LINCOLN MKX APP PART # 65-1105 CLASS III RECEIVER HITCH

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
- 2. To ease installation, the rear portion of the exhaust system should be dropped. This can be accomplished by removing the three rear rubber exhaust hangers. A strap of some kind should be used on a forward portion of the exhaust to provide support to prevent damage. FIGURE 1
- 3. There are two silver colored steel plates that must be removed in order to proceed with the installation. These will be re-attached with the tabs trimmed. FIGURE 2
- 4. At the driver side uni-body channel. Guide one M12 stud plate into the two front most mounting hole through the rear of the unibody channel using the provided M12 fishwire tool. Perform for both the driver and passenger side channels. FIGURE 3,4
- 5. The tabs for the steel plates need to be trimmed to allow access to the rear most holes. The plate can then be reinstalled using the remaining factory screws.
- 6. The hitch assembly can now be raised to the uni-body channels. Fasten the hitch to the already installed stud plates with the provided M12 flat washers, split lock washers and hex nuts. No not fully tighten at this time. FIGURE 5,6
- At the rearmost holes of the hitch assembly, Drill a 1/2"-9/16" hole through the hitch bracket and the uni-body sheet metal. Then an additional M12 stud plate can be placed inside each channel. Fasten each side with the provided M12 flat washer, split lock washer, and hex nut. FIGURE 7
- 8. Align the hitch assembly as desired then torque all M12 hex nuts to 75-80 lbs-ft. The exhaust can now be re-attached to the chassis using the original rubber hangers. FIGURE 8




