



Set your vehicle specific measurement.





Position SuperJoe Pro on vehicle.

PLACEMENT WILL VARY DEPENDING ON VEHICLE.

Upper Frame:


 The position is relative to the lower frame and will depend on vehicle shape.

Lower Frame:

- LOWER SUPPORT FRAME LOCATION IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO THE LOAD!
- A common location is a well supported license plate depression, just above or below the numbers.
- Use area with the greatest support.
- Do not place the lower frame on glass, plastic, or thin metal.
- Some SUV's, vans, and wagons have a large section of poorly supported metal that will dent under weight.



Clean the contact points on the vehicle, and keep the pads free of debris.






- Some bumpers and body panels can deform or "tin-can". Do not place in these areas. This can result in vehicle damage, or an insecure fit.
- Do not place SuperJoe Pro on vehicle's emblem.



Attach both top strap hooks (labeled TOP) around top edge of the trunk lid, hatch lid, or rear door.


Attach bottom hooks.

Attach both bottom strap hooks (labeled BOTTOM). Appropriate attachment points will depend on your specific vehicle.

Acceptable attachment points may include the bottom edge of the trunk, hatch lid, or rear door. Or the tie down hooks underneath the vehicle. Or the metal ledge of the bumper. Only attach hooks to areas with sufficient support.




Route the straps over the SuperJoe frame as shown.

TIGHTEN ALL STRAPS COMPLETELY. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.


TOP HOOKS: Glass Hatch Adapter installation instructions



Remove the upper top strap and top hooks.







Pass the Glass Hatch Adapter strap ends through the hatch opening from inside the vehicle.



Keep the pads away from the door's edge.







BEFORE CLOSING THE HATCH...

The pads must be free from contact between hatch door and vehicle's frame.

Straps should be parallel with the top buckles.




CLOSE THE HATCH.

Pull firmly on the straps to seat the pads.





THREAD NEW STRAP-ENDS INTO SUPERJOE PRO BUCKLES.




While supporting the carrier with your body, attach the new straps to your carrier's top buckles.

Adjust upper straps by pulling on the ends TOWARD THE VEHICLE.



OPEN THE TRUNK DOOR.




Position the pads inside the trunk with the straps

hanging free.




D BEFORE CLOSING THE TRUNK:

Be sure the pads are free from contact between trunk door and vehicle's frame.




- CLOSE THE TRUNK.
- Pull firmly on the straps to seat the pads.



Now that you've installed the bottom glass hatch adapters continue to STEP 5.




Secure all loose strap ends by bundling them together and tucking them into the flexible bands located on the straps.






8 Load bike(s).



- Rotate anti-sway cradles out of the way for easier loading.
- · Load heaviest bike first.
- Always load first bike with chain away from vehicle.
- Load Bikes starting in spots closest to the vehicle.
- Use Wheel Strap to secure bike's front wheel to its frame.

Alternate bike directions to avoid interference.


A Yakima TubeTop (see cover page) may be required to carry your bike safely.




Bikes should be as level as possible to avoid ground clearance issues and possible ejections.




Failure to load bikes properly can result in property damage, personal injury, or death.





RECOMMENDED ACCESSORIES (SOLD SEPARATELY)




YAKIMA TUBETOP (YAKIMA PART NUMBER 8002531)

Required for bikes with step-through/Ladies frames or bikes with slanted top tubes.

Secures your bikes to your carrier.



TRUNK SECURITY STRAP (YAKIMA PART NUMBER 8002623)

Secures your carrier to your vehicle.
