Soft Tonneau Covers

How do I care for my Vinyl Tonneau Cover?

The vinyl fabric on your tonneau cover can be cleaned with mild soap and water, and may be hand washed or safely cleaned in the car wash of your choice. Thoroughly rinse cover to remove any soap residue. Vinyl cover can be treated with any vinyl protectant made for tonneau covers. Never clean cover with petroleum or citrus-based products, avoid silicone based protectant.

Will the Yukon Trail Soft Cover work in the winter as well as in the summer?

The tonneau cover fabric will not shrink or crack in cold temperatures, to -40 degrees F. The soft covers are resigned to hold their tension whether it is 40 degrees below or 120 degrees above.

Can I still open my tailgate with the Yukon Trail Tonneau Cover on my truck?

Yes - it does not restrict the tailgate. The rear header functions independently of the tailgate so there is nothing to remove when opening the tailgate.

I have an older truck and I don't see the year in the application guide. Can I still get a Yukon Trail Fiberglass or Soft Tonneau cover for my truck?

Yes. Yukon Trail can be custom cut for classic or antique applications. Just call our customer support indicating measurements, truck information, and cover information.

I live in a region that is very hot. Will the Yukon Trail fabric fade in the sun?

The fabric used in the Yukon Trail Soft Tonneau Cover is very high industrial grade quality and has been tested in extreme conditions. It is UV-protected and will not fade in the sun.

I live in a region that gets a lot of heavy snow. Can the Yukon Trail Soft Tonneau Cover hold the snow without bending or stretching?

The fabric used in Yukon Trail Tonneau Covers is very high quality and has been tested in extreme conditions. It can hold up to 350 pounds without stretching the fabric.

I would like to install the Yukon Trail Tonneau Cover myself. How long will it take to install it myself?

Typically, the Yukon Trail Tonneau Cover can be installed easily in minutes! See the Installation guide for more detailed installation instructions.

Will the Yukon Trail Tonneau Cover work with a drop in bed liner that goes over the bed rails?

Yes, any Yukon Trail Tonneau Cover will work with a drop in bed liner that goes over the bed rails. However, installation for this particular application will vary slightly from the normal installation process. Small holes (approximately 2"x4") would need to be cut in the bed liner where the clamps will be installed. This allows access to the inner lip of the truck bed. If the liner goes over the front bulkhead and creates a radius at the front, you may need to cut slits in the bed liner at the front of the bed to allow the rails to push further forward in the bed.
